### **REGISTRY OF DEEDS RELEASES CONSUMER NOTIFICATION SYSTEM**

SPRINGFIELD, Mass.— Hampden County Registry of Deeds, announced today that the office will now offer a Consumer Notification System. This notification system is part of an update to the office’s website.

Hampden County property owners who sign up for the Consumer Notification System will receive email notifications every time a new document is recorded and indexed with their name. The Registry offers this service, free of charge, to give customers a way to receive real-time updates about their property.

“Customer service is our top priority at the Registry of Deeds,” says Acting Register Kelly Cavanaugh-Kelly. “Our customers deserve to know immediately if something has been recorded in their name. Whether it’s a lien, a discharge, or a potentially fraudulent document, it’s our duty to keep our customers informed.”
